The following table shows the changes in the total number of livestock in the Arunachal Pradesh during the two inter census period.



In Census 2012, the total livestock population has been distributed under various species as per diagram given below:

Distribution of Livestock Population



The diagram above shows that among the total livestock, Cattle contributes highest with 32.83% followed by Pigs 25.23%, Goat 21.63%, Mithuns 17.63% and Yak 1% besides marginal contribution is attributed by other livestock species such as Buffalo, Sheep, Camel, Mules, Donkeys, Horses and Ponies. The variation in the number of animals in different species of livestock in comparison to the previous census is shown in the table 3.2:




Trend of total livestock population 2003-2012

The change in the total livestock population over past 3 livestock censuses is depicted below:



Cattle

The total cattle population is 0.464 million numbers in the state. There is an increase from 0.458 million cattle in 2003 to 0.464 million cattle in 2012. However, there is a decrease in number of cattle with 7.82% during the inter censuses period (2007-2012).




The above graph shows that the total exotic/crossbred cattle population has increased from 0.013 million in 2003 to 0.023 million in census 2012. The indigenous cattle population has decreased from 0.445 million in 2003 to 0.441 million in 2012. The exotic/crossbred and indigenous cattle population has shown negative

growths of 20.4% and 7.05% respectively during the inter censuses period (2007-2012).


Trends in the Share of Exotic/Crossbred and Indigenous Cattle Population

The diagram below shows the trends in the percentage share of exotic/crossbred and indigenous cattle over the cattle population during the period 2003-2012.




Cattle-Female

The total number female cattle in the state is 0.26 million as per census 2012. The number of female cattle has increased from 0.25 million in 2003 to 0.26 million in 2012 as depicted in the diagram below. However, over the previous census the female cattle population has decreased by 5.26%.




District-wise Cattle Population

The graph below shows that the District Lohit has the highest contribution in cattle population with 15.02%. The second and third highest contributors are Changlang and Papum Pare with share of cattle population of 13.37% and 11.73% respectively.



Buffalo


The total buffalo population is 0.006 million numbers in the state. There is an increase in number of buffaloes with 86.10% during the inter censuses period (2007-2012).



As per the above diagram it is evident that the female buffalo population has decreased from 0.008 million in 2003 to 0.003 million in 2012. However, the female buffalo population has increased by 45.83% during the inter censuses period (2007-2012).


District-wise Buffalo Population

The graph below shows that the District Lohit has the highest contribution in buffalo population with 27.81%. The second and third highest contributors are Lower Subansiri and Lower Dibang Valley with share of buffalo population of 18.78% and 13.97% respectively.



Mithuns & Yaks


The total number of mithuns & yaks together in the state as per 2012 census is 0.26 million numbers.



The total number of mithuns have increased from 0.19 million numbers in 2003 to 0.24 million numbers in 2012. The total yak population has increased from 0.009 million in 2003 to 0.014 million in 2012. The mithun & yak population has shown growths of 13.73% and -1.33% respectively during the inter censuses period (2007-2012).


District-wise Mithuns Population

The graph below shows that the District of Papum Pare has the highest contribution in mithun population with 18.49%. The second and third highest contributors are Kurung Kumey and Lower Subansiri with share of mithuns population of 15.77% and 14.38% respectively.



District-wise Yaks Population


The graph below shows that the District of Tawang has the highest contribution in yaks population with 56.49%. The second and third highest contributors are West Kameng and Kurung Kumey with share of Yaks population of 28.08% and 3.63% respectively.



Sheep

The total number of sheep in the state as per census 2012 is 0.014 million numbers. The number of sheep declined by 31.85% during the inter censuses period (2007-2012).


Graph 3.12: Sheep Population in year 2003-2012



The exotic/crossbred and indigenous sheep population has shown growth of -69.18% and -21.39% respectively during the inter censuses period (2007-2012).

District-wise Sheep Population


The graph below shows that the District of Tawang has the highest contribution in sheep population with 55.35%. The second and third highest contributors are West Kameng and Papum Pare with share of sheep population of 26.30% and 7.37% respectively.



Goat

The total number of goat in the state as per census 2012 is 0.30 million numbers. There is a 4.59% increase in number of goat population during the inter censuses period (2007-2012).

Graph 3.14: Goat Population 2003-2012




The diagram above shows that the total number of female goat population has increased from 0.14 million in 2003 to 0.17 million in 2012. The female goat population has increased by 5.13% over the previous census. The male goat population has increased from 0.086 million in 2003 to 0.12 million in 2012. The population of male goat has increased by 3.84% during the inter censuses period (2007-2012).

District-wise Goat Population

The graph below shows that the District of Papum Pare has the major contribution in goat population of 14.83%. The second and third highest contributors are Changlang and Lohit with share of goat population of 11.92% and 10.21% respectively.


Graph 3.15: Percentage share of Goat Population - 2012



Pigs

The total number of pigs in the state as per census 2012 is 0.35 million numbers. There is a 0.21% increase in number of pigs during the inter censuses period (2007-2012).

Graph 3.16: Total Pigs during 2003-2012




The number of exotic/crossbred pig has increased from 0.008 million in 2003 to 0.03 million in 2012. The number of indigenous pig has decreased from 0.32 million in 2003 to 0.31 million in 2012. The exotic/crossbred and indigenous pig population have shown a growth of -23.82% and 4.06% respectively during the inter censuses period (2007-2012).

District-wise Pig Population

The graph below shows that the District of West Siang has the highest contribution in pig population of 11.43%. The second and third highest contributors are Papum Pare and Kurung Kumey with share of pig population of 10.86% and 10.06% respectively.


Graph 3.17: Percentage share of Pig Population - 2012



Horses & ponies

The total number of horses& ponies in the state as per 2012 census is 0.004 million numbers. There is a 27.27% decrease in number of horses& ponies during the inter censuses period (2007-2012).


Graph 3.18: Total Horses & Ponies during 2003-2012

The graph below shows that the District West Kameng has the highest contribution in horses & ponies population of 61.26%. The second and third highest contributors are Tawang and West Siang with share of horses & ponies of 22.72% and 8.12% respectively.


Graph 3.19: Percentage Share of Horses & Ponies Population - 2012



Poultry

Poultry consists of generally three categories namely fowls, ducks, turkey & others. The total poultry in the state is 2.24 million numbers. The changes in the poultry population over previous 3 censuses are depicted in the graph below:

Graph 3.20: Total Poultry 2003-2012




The number of poultry birds has increased from 1.74 million numbers in 2003 to 2.24 million numbers in 2012. There is an increase of 66.43% in the poultry population over the previous census.

Fowl, Duck and Turkey & others

The diagram below shows the number of poultry birds i.e. fowl, duck and turkey & others over the period 2003-2012.


Graph 3.21: Total Poultry (Fowls, Ducks, Turkey & Others)



The diagram above shows that the fowls have decreased from 1.61 million numbers in 2003 to 1.20 million numbers in 2012. The fowl population has decreased by 4.09% over the previous census period. The ducks population has increased from 0.076million numbers in 2003to 0.083 million number in 2012. The ducks population has decreased by 7.58% over the previous census. The turkey and other birds have increased by from 0.056 million in 2003 to 0.95 million in 2012. The turkey population has drastically increased during inter censuses period (2007-2012).

District-wise poultry Population

The graph below shows that the District-wise percentage of poultry population.




The analysis shows that the District Changlang is having the highest contribution of poultry with 13.13%. The second and third largest contributors are Papum Pare and East Siang with 12.86% and 11.07% respectively.


Animals in milk
