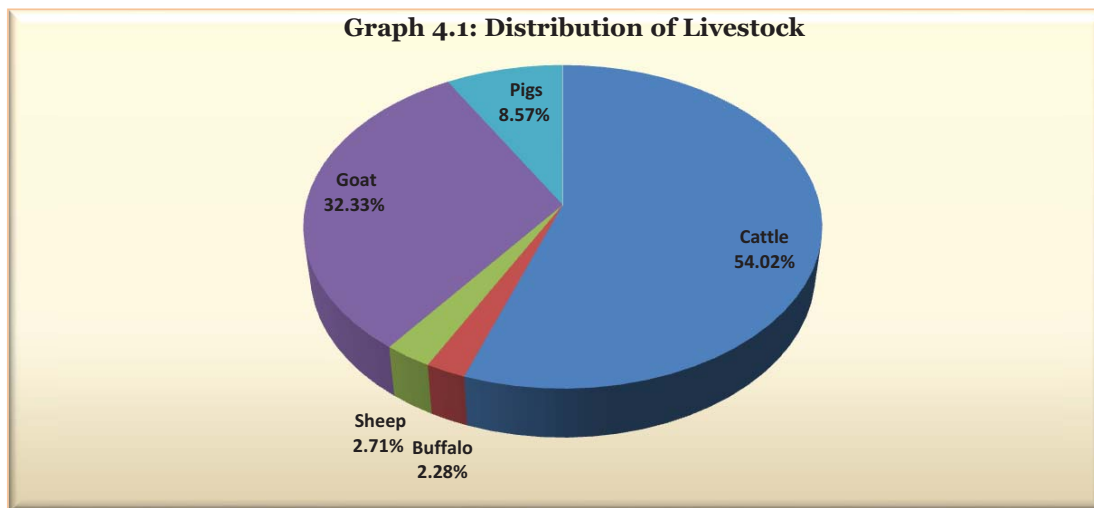
Livestock Population

The following table shows the changes in the total number of livestock in the Assam during the two inter censal period.

There is an increase in livestock population over 2007 to 2012 from 17.22 million to 19.08 million (excluding 0.022 million stray cattle) registering a positive growth of 10.77% in the total number of animals of various species. In Census 2012, the total livestock population has been distributed under various species as per diagram given below:



The diagram above shows that among the total livestock, Cattle contributes highest with 54.02% followed by Goat 32.33%, Pigs 8.57%, Sheep 2.71% and Buffalo 2.28% besides marginal contribution is attributed by other livestock species such as Camel, Mules, Donkeys, Horses and Ponies. The variation in number of animals for different species of livestock in comparison to the previous census is shown in the table 4.2:

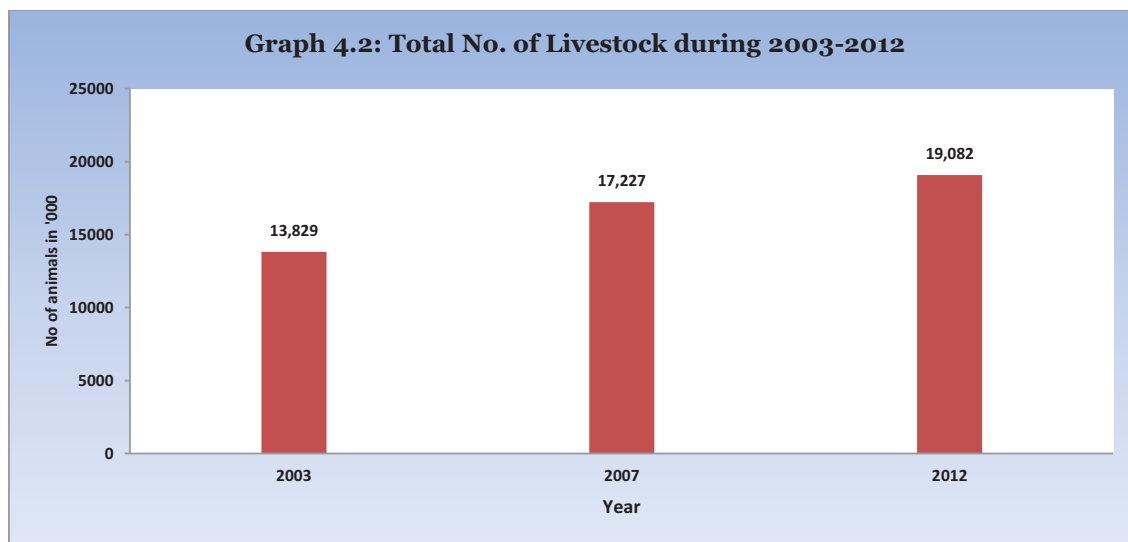

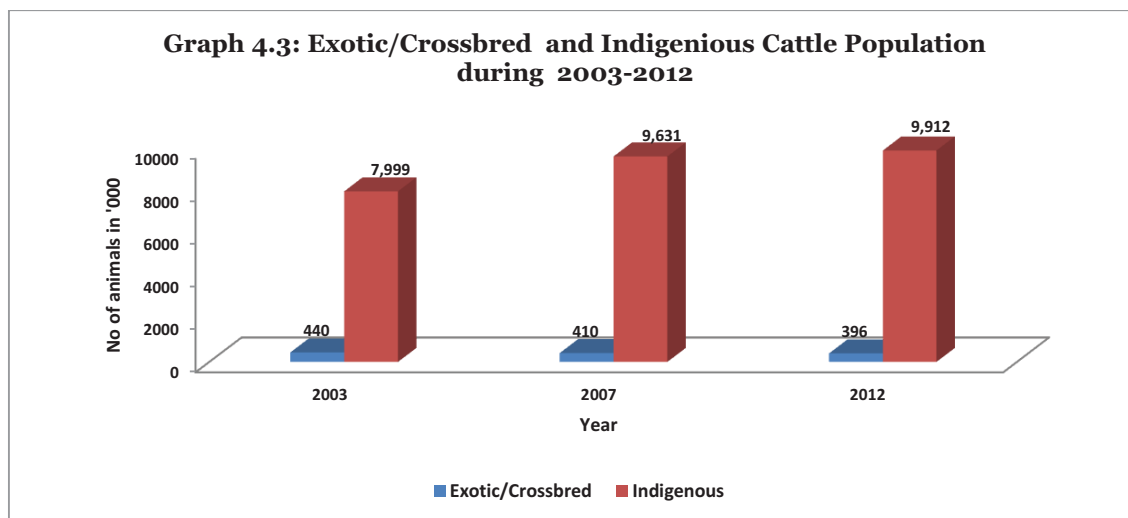
Trend of total livestock population 2003-2012

The change in the total livestock population over past 3 livestock censuses is depicted below:



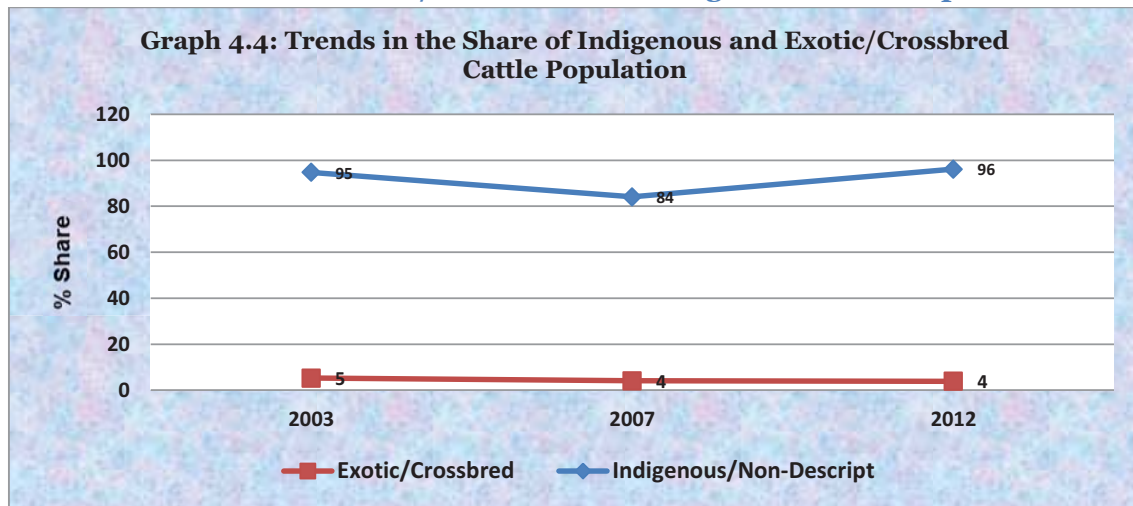
Cattle

The total cattle population in the State is 10.30 million numbers. There is an increase from 8.44 million in 2003 to 10.30 million in 2012. There is an increase in number of cattle with 2.65% during the inter censuses period (2007-2012).



The graph above shows that the total exotic/crossbred cattle population has decreased from 0.44 million in 2003 to 0.39 million in census 2012. However, the indigenous cattle population has increased from 7.99 million in 2003 to 9.91 million in 2012. The exotic/crossbred and indigenous cattle population have shown percentage changes of -3.55% and 2.92% respectively during the inter censuses period (2007-2012).

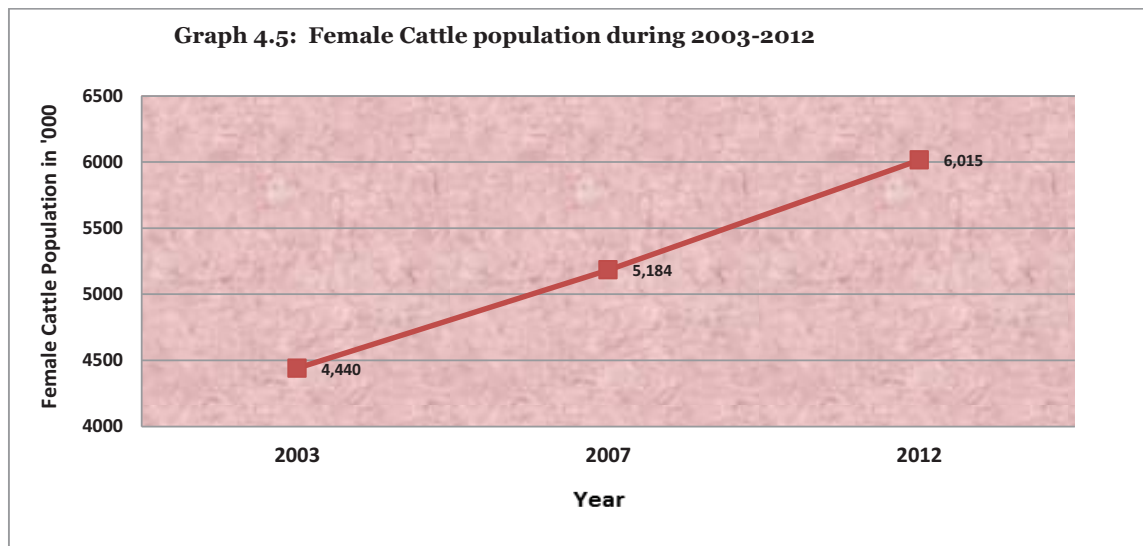
Trends in the Share of Exotic/Crossbred and Indigenous Cattle Population



The diagram above shows the trends in the percentage share of indigenous and exotic/crossbred cattle over total cattle population during the period 2003-2012. The percentage share of exotic/crossbred cattle is decreasing over the period 2003-2012. However, the indigenous category is increasing.

Cattle-Female

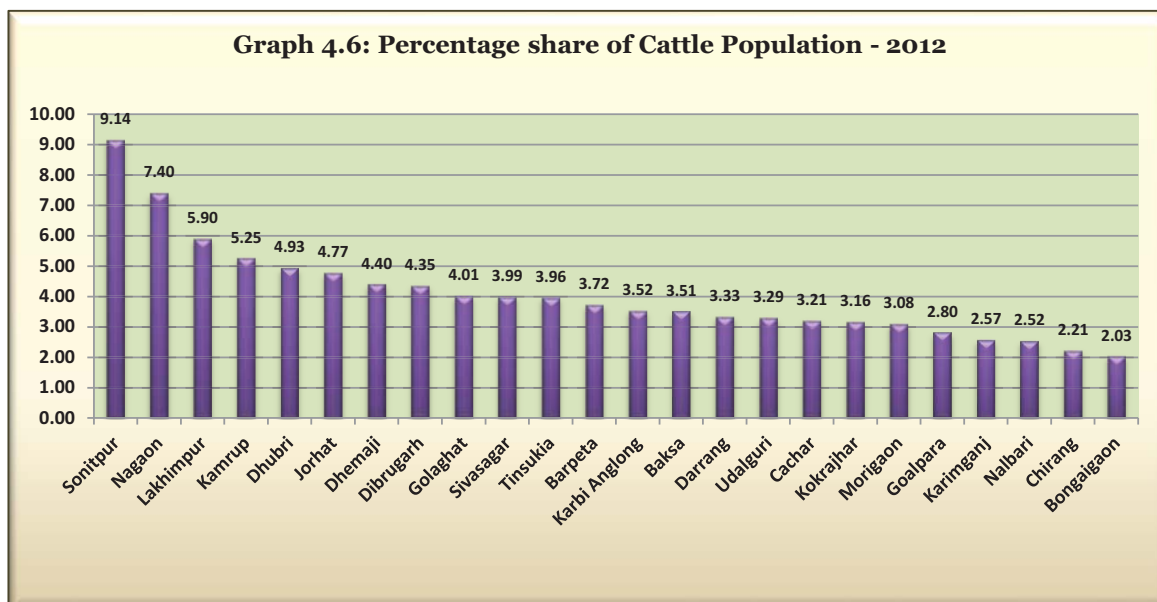
The total number of female cattle in the state is 6.01 million as per census 2012. The number of female cattle has increased from 4.44 million in 2003 to 6.01 million in 2012 as depicted in the diagram below. However over the previous census the female cattle population has decreased by 27.31%.



District-wise Cattle Population

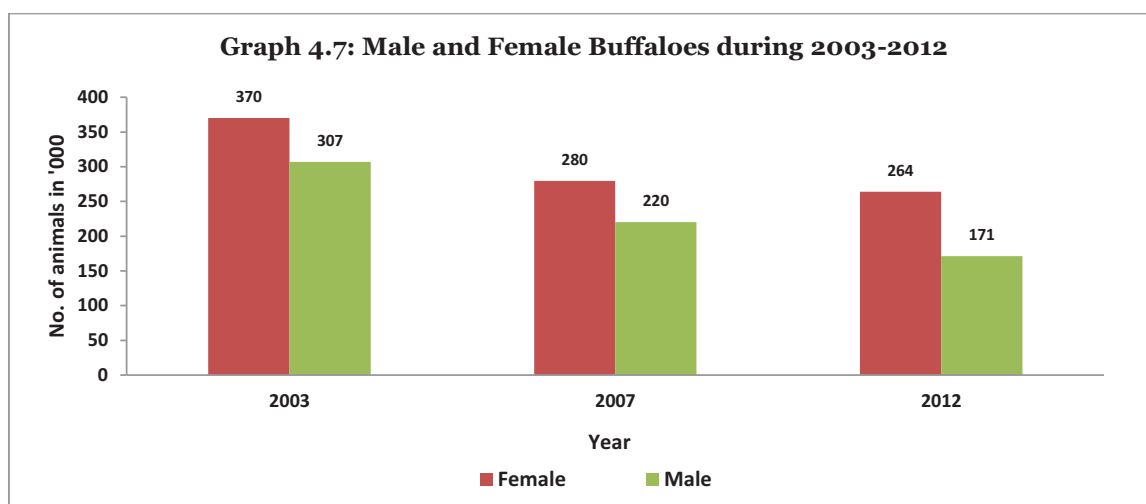
The graph below shows that the District of Sonitpur has the highest contribution in cattle population with 9.14%. The second and third highest contributors are Nagaon

and Lakhimpur with share of cattle population of 7.40% and 5.90% respectively.



Buffalo

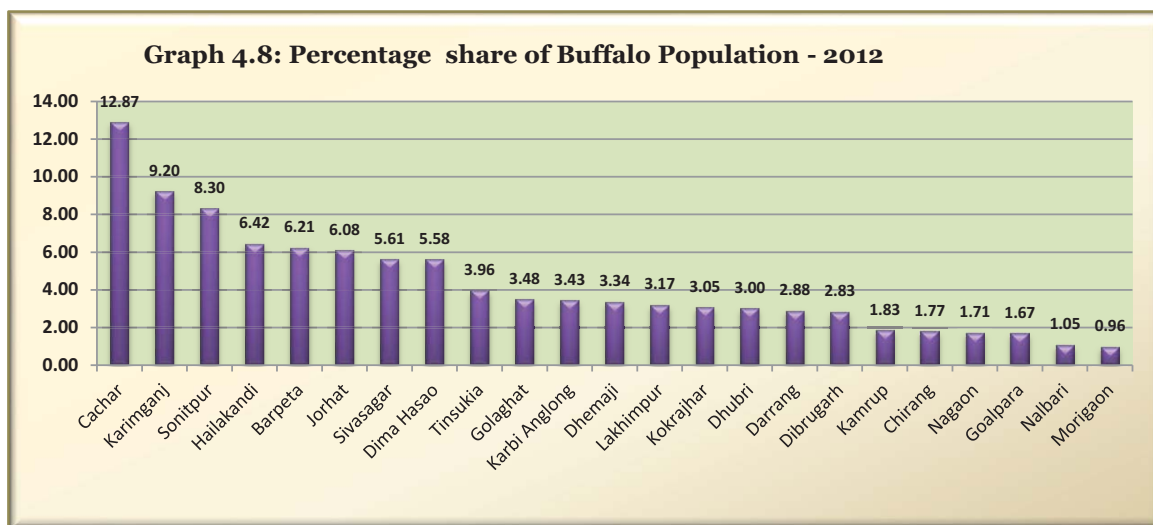
The total buffalo population is 0.43 million numbers in the state. There is a decrease in number of buffaloes with 12.93% during the inter censuses period (2007-2012).



As per the above diagram it is evident that the female buffalo population has decreased from 0.37 million in 2003 to 0.26 million in 2012. The female buffalo population has decreased by 5.65% during the inter censuses period (2007-2012).

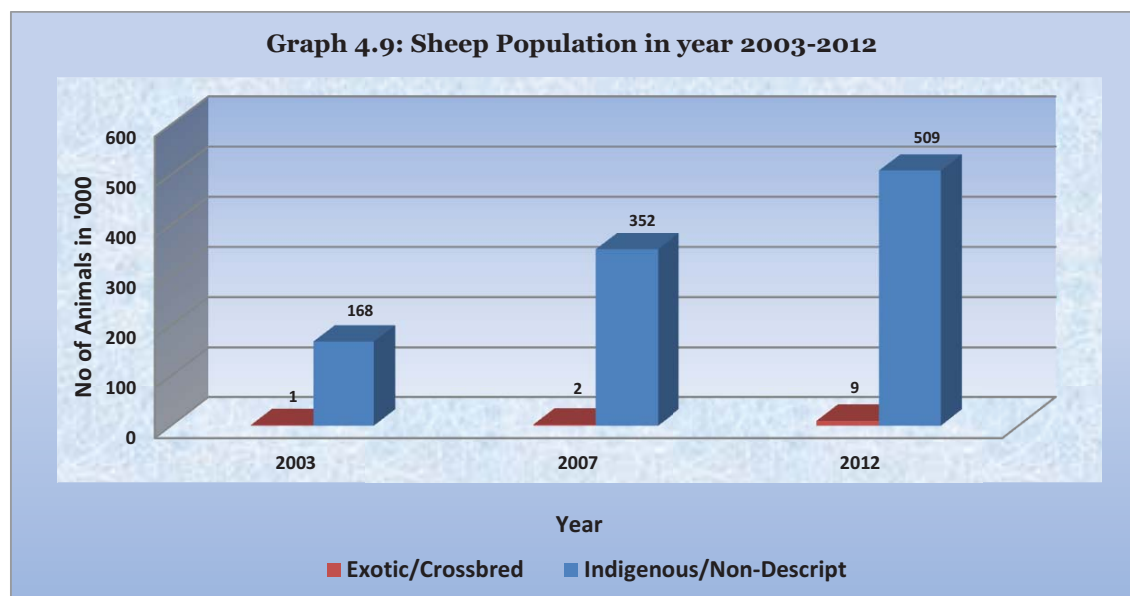
District-wise Buffalo Population

The graph below shows that the District of Cachar has the highest contribution in buffalo population of 12.87%. The second and third highest contributors are Karimganj and Sonitpur with share of buffalo population of 9.20% and 8.30% respectively.



Sheep

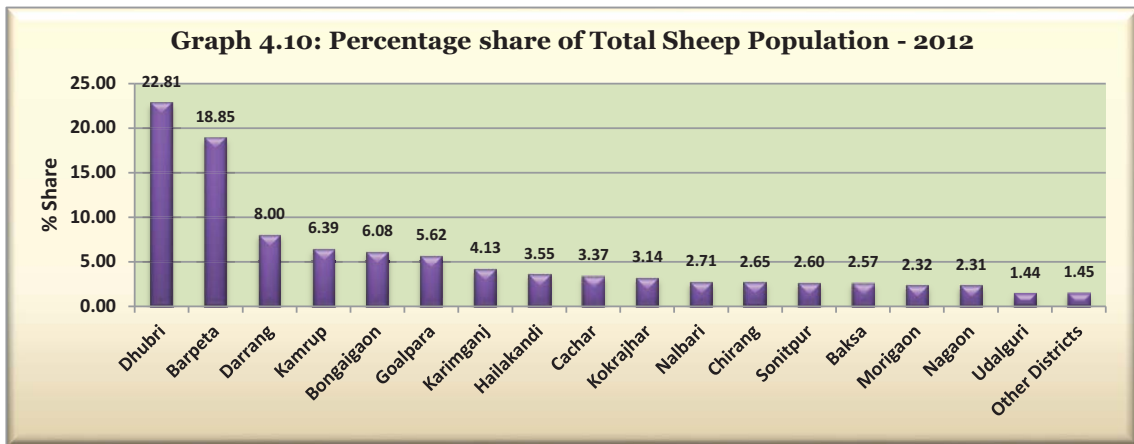
The total sheep population is 0.51 million numbers in the state. There is a 46.43% increase in number of sheep during the inter censuses period (2007-2012).



The number of Indigenous sheep has increased from 0.16 million in 2003 to 0.50 million in 2012. The exotic/crossbred and Indigenous sheep population has shown percentage changes of 368.26% and 46.43% respectively during the inter censuses period (2007-2012).

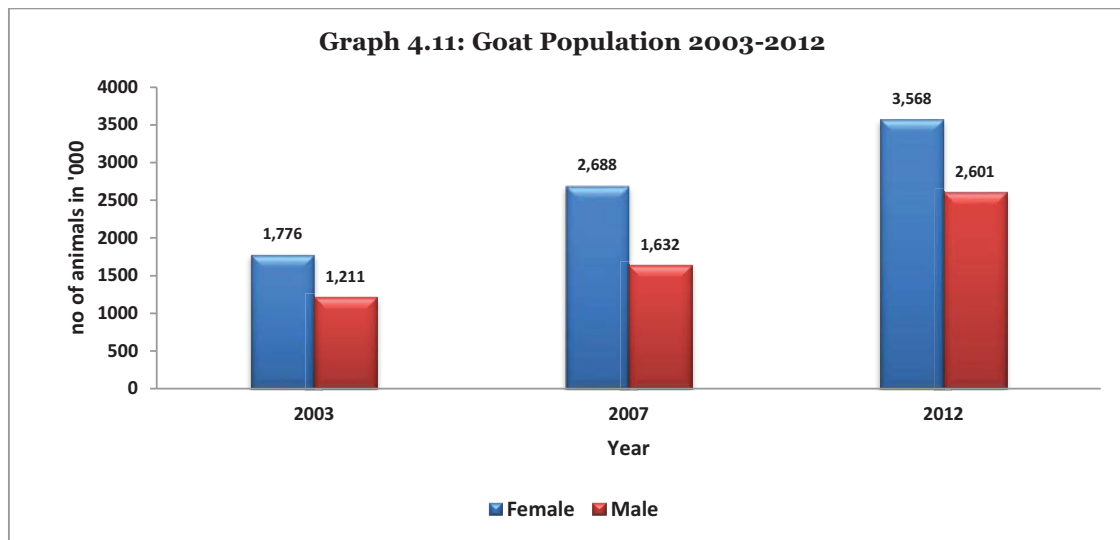
District-wise Sheep Population

The graph below shows that the District of Dhubri has the highest contribution in sheep population of 22.81%. The second and third highest contributors are Barpeta and Darrang with share of sheep population of 18.85% and 8% respectively.



Goat

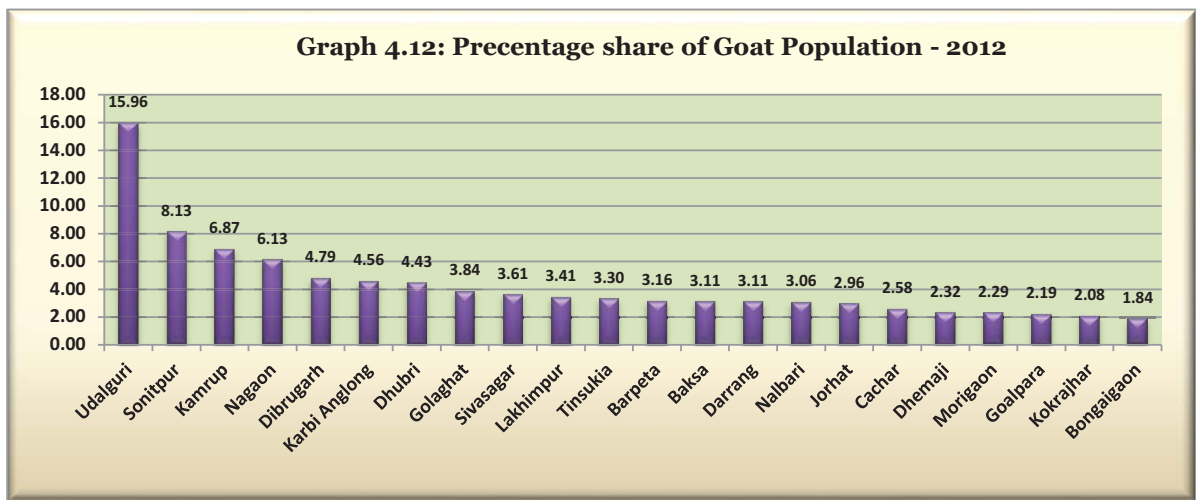
The total number of goat in the state as per census 2012 is 6.16 million numbers. There is a 46.43% increase in number of goat population during the inter censuses period (2007-2012).



The diagram above shows that the total number of female goat population has increased from 1.77 million in 2003 to 3.56 million in 2012. The female goat population has increased by 32.77% over the previous census. The male goat population has increased from 1.21 million in 2003 to 2.60 million in 2012. The population of male goat has increased by 59.34% during the inter censuses period (2007-2012).

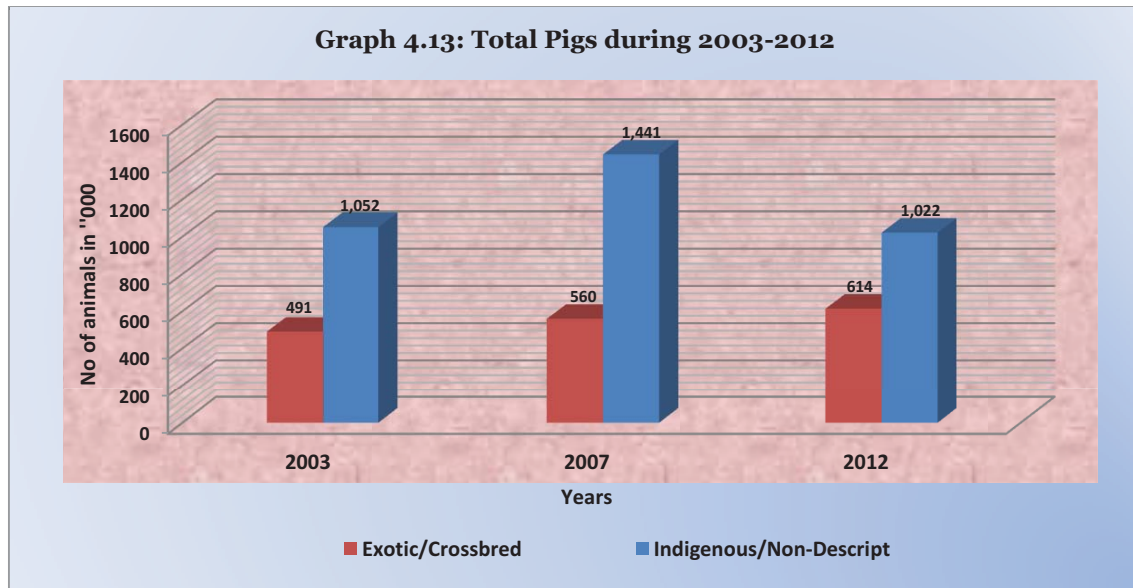
District-wise Goat Population

The graph below shows that the District of Udalguri has the major contribution in goat population of 15.96%. The second and third highest contributors are Sonitpur and Kamrup with share of goat population of 8.13% and 6.87% respectively.



Pigs

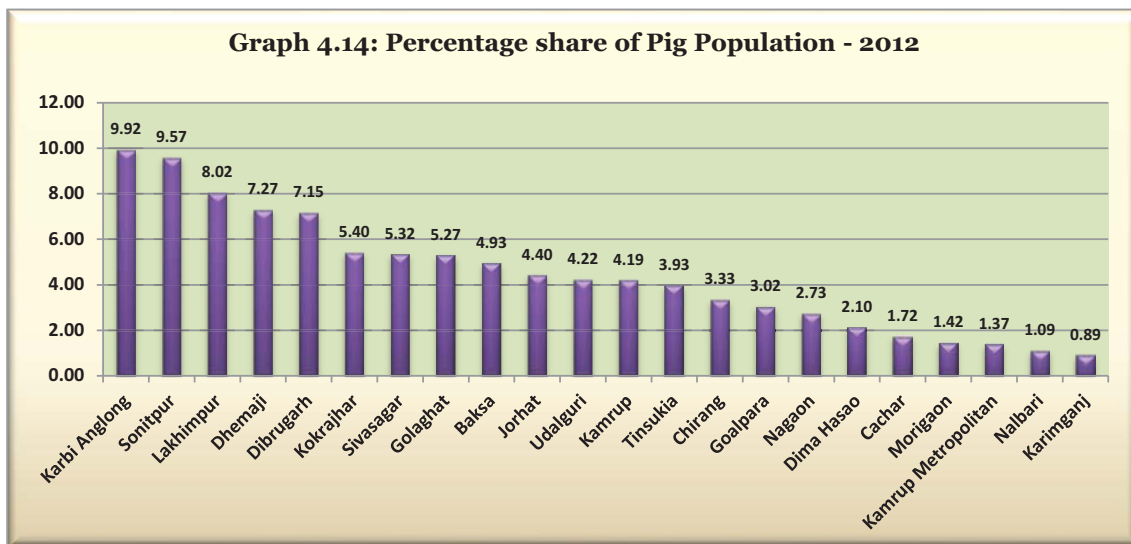
The total number of pigs in the state as per census 2012 is 1.63 million numbers. There is an 18.22% decrease in number of pigs during the inter censuses period (2007-2012).



The number of exotic/crossbred pig has increased from 0.49 million in 2003 to 0.61 million in 2012. However, the number of indigenous pig has decreased from 1.05 million in 2003 to 1.02 million in 2012. The exotic/crossbred and indigenous pig population have shown percentage changes of 9.66% and -29.04% respectively during the inter censuses period (2007-2012).

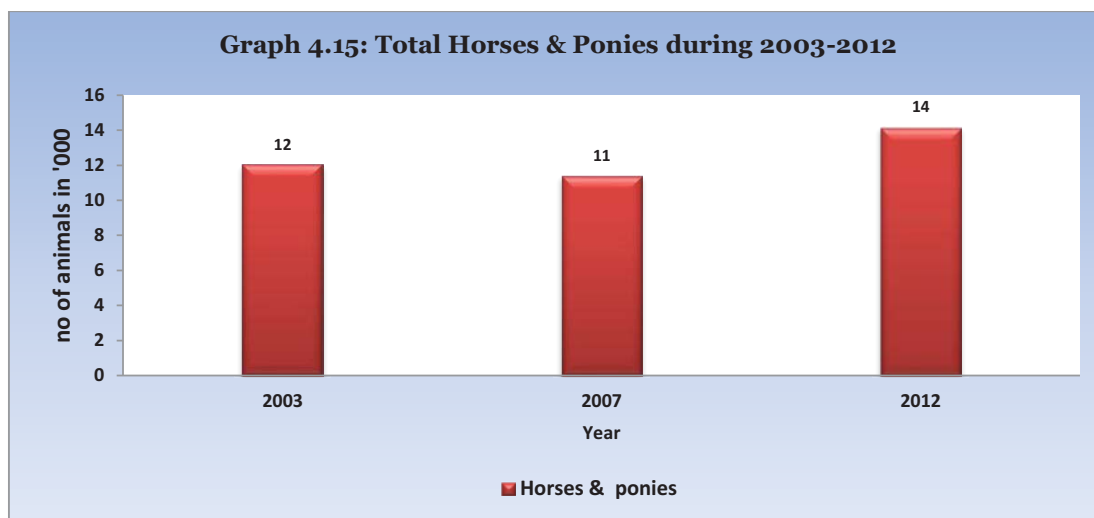
District-wise Pig Population

The graph below shows that the District of Karbi Anglong has the highest contribution in pig population of 9.92%. The second and third highest contributors are Sonitpur and Lakhimpur with share of pig population of 9.57% and 8.02% respectively.



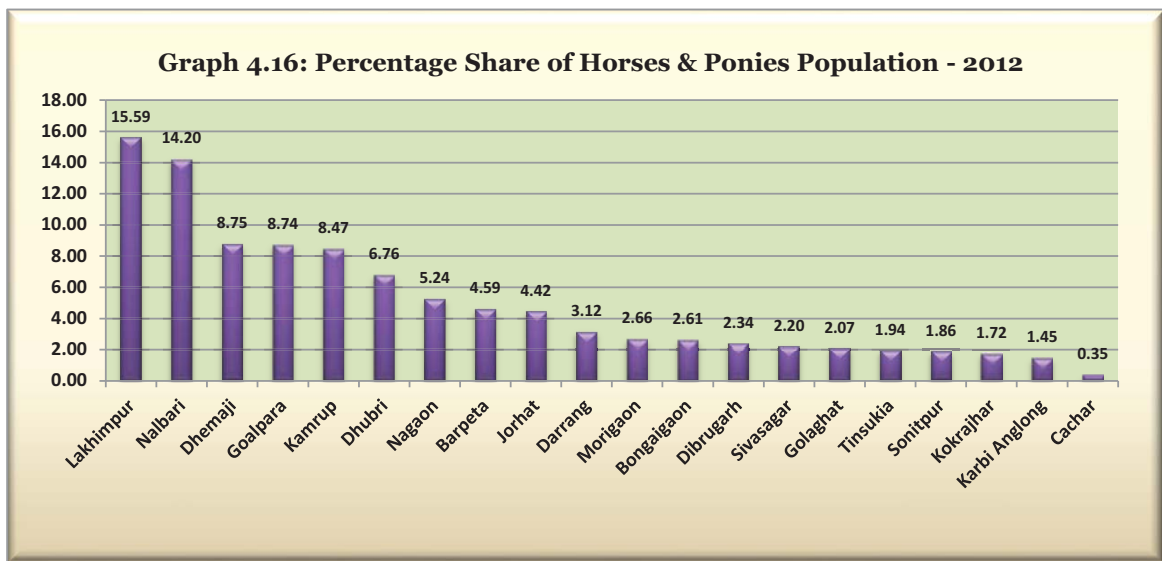
Horses & ponies

The total number of horses & ponies in the state as per 2012 census is 0.014million numbers registering 24.59% increase in number of horses & ponies during the inter censuses period (2007-2012).



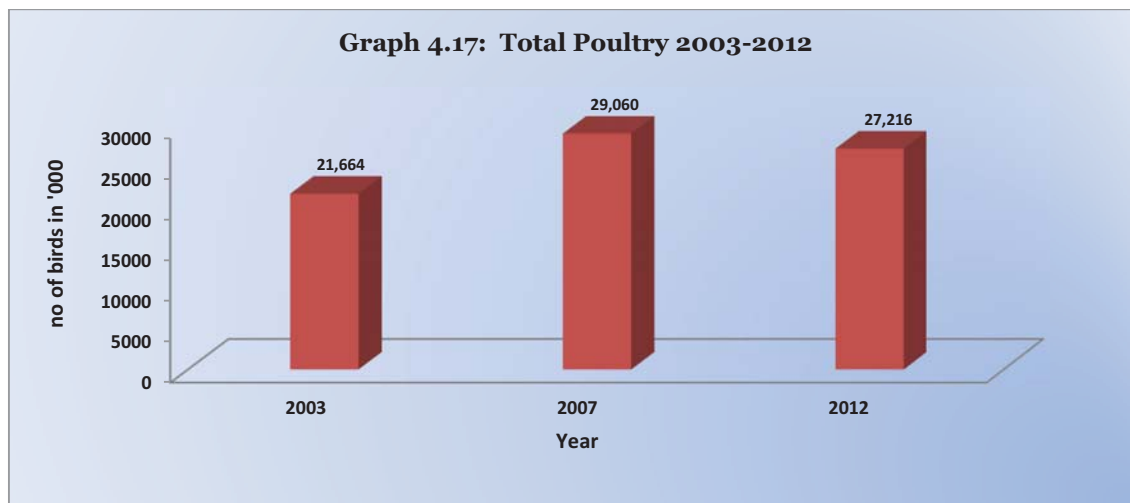
District-wise Horses & Ponies Population

The graph below shows that the District Lakhimpur has the highest contribution in horses & ponies population of 15.59%. The second and third highest contributors are Nalbari and Dhemaji with share of horses & ponies of 14.20% and 8.75% respectively.



Poultry

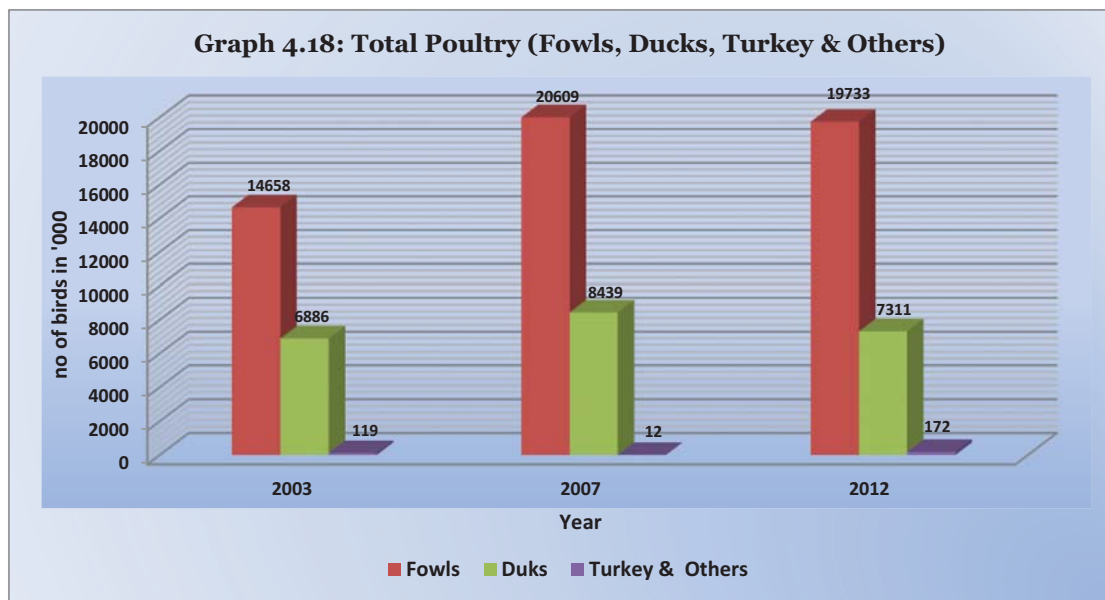
Poultry consists of generally three categories namely fowls, ducks, turkey & others. The total poultry in the state is 27.21 million numbers. The changes in the poultry population over previous 3 censuses are depicted in the graph below:



The numbers of poultry birds have increased from 21.66 million numbers in 2003 to 27.21 million numbers in 2012. There is a decrease of 6.35% in the poultry population over the previous census.

Fowl, Duck and Turkey and others

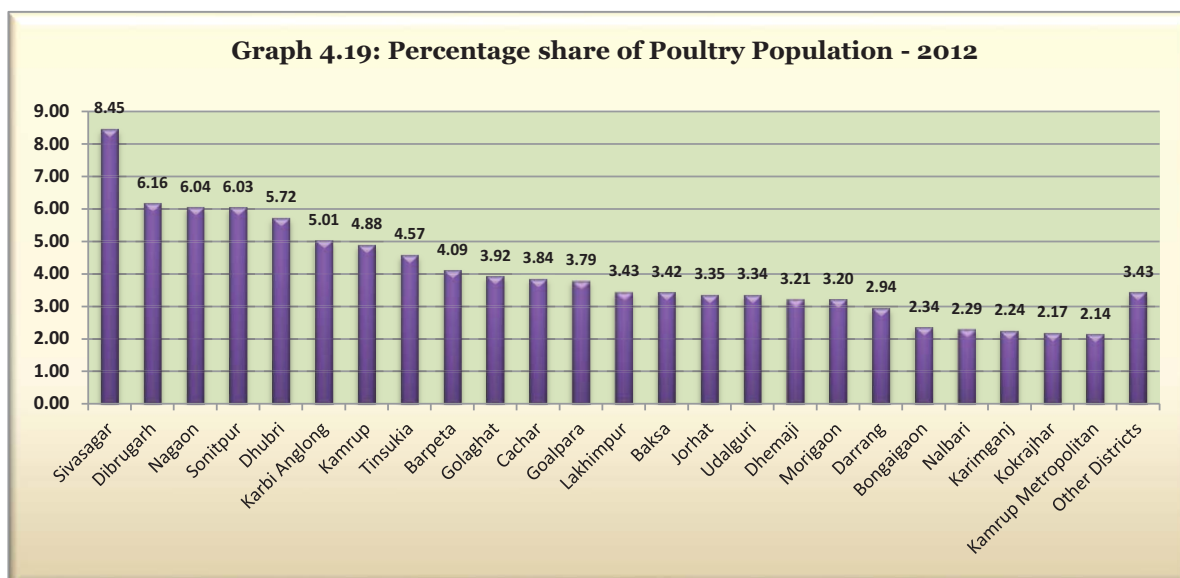
The diagram below shows the number of poultry birds i.e. fowl, duck and turkey and others over the period 2003-2012.



The diagram above shows that the fowls have increased from 14.65 million numbers in 2003 to 19.73 million numbers in 2012. The fowl population has decreased by 4.25% over the previous census period. The ducks population has increased from 6.88 million numbers in 2003 to 7.31 million number in 2012. However, the ducks population has decreased by 13.37% over the previous census. The turkey and other birds have increased from 0.11 million in 2003 to 0.17 million in 2012. The turkey population has drastically increased during inter censuses period (2007-2012).

District-wise poultry Population

The graph below shows that the District-wise percentage of poultry population.

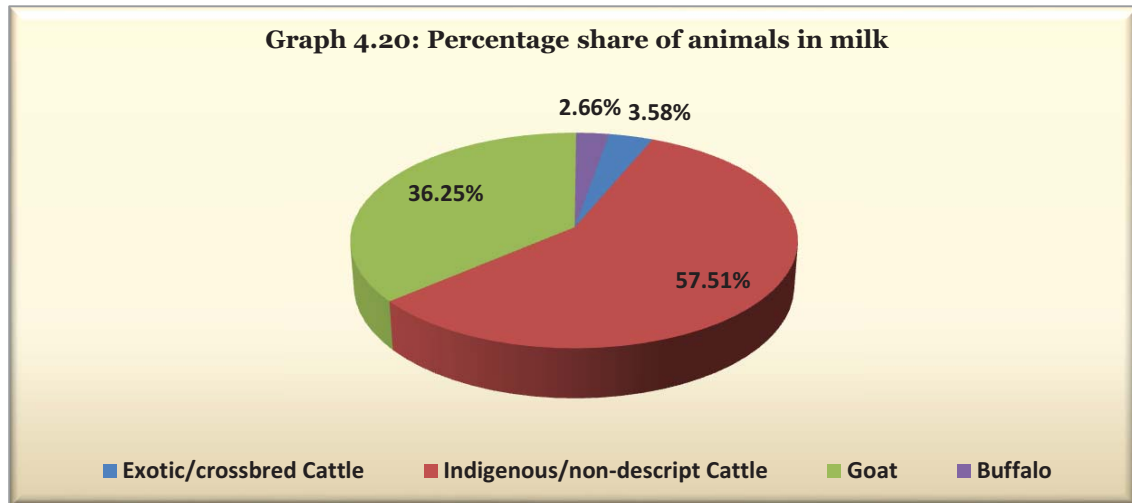


The analysis shows that the District Shivasagar having the highest contribution of 8.45%. The second and third largest contributors are Dibrugarh and Nagaon with 6.16% and 6.04% respectively.

Uses- Cattle, Buffalo and Goat

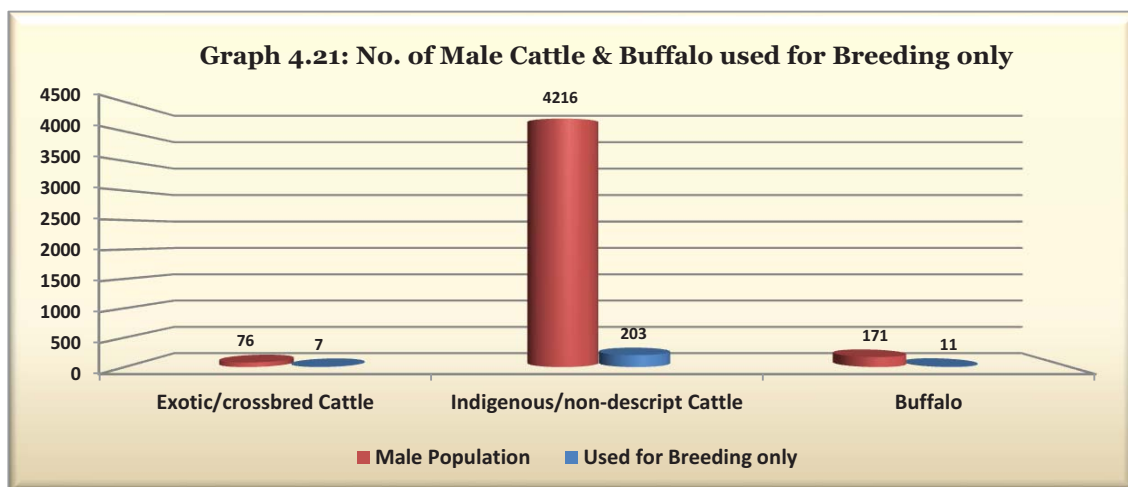
Animals in milk
